## 2023 Tax Preparation Engagement Letter

We appreciate the opportunity to work with you. To minimize the possibility of a misunderstanding between us, we are explaining important information about the services we will provide for you.

We will prepare your 2023 federal, state and local tax returns from information that you furnish us. We will not audit or otherwise verify the data you submit, although we may ask you to clarify some of the information.

We must receive the majority of your tax information before assigning your placement number. We understand some documents are unattainable until later in the calendar year. If you receive a late document, K-1 or broker statement, please get to us asap, but no later than April 8<sup>th</sup> to avoid an extension. We will let you know at drop off if we expect to finish your return prior to April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. If we are not able to finish, we may have to request an extension of time from the tax authorities, and you may be subject to late payment penalties and interest on tax amounts due and not paid by April 15<sup>th</sup>.

It is your responsibility to maintain, in your records, the documentation necessary to support the data used in preparing your tax returns, including but not limited to the auto, travel, entertainment, and related expenses and the required documents to support charitable contributions. If you have any questions as to required documentation, please let us know. It is also your responsibility to examine and approve your completed tax returns before signing them and mailing them or authorizing us to e-file them to the tax authorities. We are not responsible for the disallowance of deductions without adequate support documentation, nor for the resulting taxes, penalties and interest.

We are responsible for preparing only the returns listed above. Our fee does not include responding to inquiries or examinations by taxing authorities, misprocessing of your return by the IRS or other government agency or any tax identity theft issues. However, we are available to represent you in such matters, but additional fees for that representation will apply at standard rates.

If we make an error on any of your tax returns that later results in additional taxes, penalties and interest, we will reimburse for the penalties and interest caused by our error. We will use our professional judgment and expertise to resolve questions in your favor whenever a tax law is unclear, as long as there is reasonable basis for doing so. Whenever there are conflicting interpretations, or alternative positions that may be taken on your tax returns, we will follow whichever position you request, so long as it is consistent with the applicable tax codes and regulations. If a tax authority should later contest such a requested position, and there is an assessment of additional tax, penalties or interest, we will assume no liability for such an assessment.

Our fees for tax preparation are due and payable in full upon completion and release of your tax returns to you. Unfortunately, we cannot allow any exceptions to this requirement, but for your convenience we will accept cash, check or credit card.
